How To Become A Service Crew Applicant 2009

Joining the Service Crew team is the first time most guys will be a part of the Stony Glen Brigade Camp staff. It's different. It's hard work. However, it is one of the very important ministries at summer camp. Being a part of the Service Crew is rewarding to the young man who is looking to make a significant impact in the running of camp, in the team of staff members, and in the lives of boys from all over Ohio. It is also a good stepping stone toward becoming A Junior Counselor at Stony Glen Brigade Camp.

If you think it's for you, you need to know a few things first:

1. A new team is selected each year - based on the application and reference forms. We prefer workers who plan on at least one week of camp as a camper.
2. You need to be willing to work wherever the camp needs you. You are volunteering to provide necessary cleaning so that campers have a Great week.
3. Expenses require each applicant to raise a prayer support team.
4. Although many of our Service Crew team members go on to be Junior Counselors, it is not guaranteed.
5. If space permits, you will be bunking in the staff cabin with other Central Staff and Service Crew members.

If you still want to proceed, great! Now do the following:

1. Read the Job Description carefully.
2. Fill out both parts of the Application form (General Information and Personal Information) and mail immediately.
3. Distribute the two (2) Reference forms* as follows
 - one to a church leader, such as a senior pastor or youth pastor
 - one to a Brigade leader, teacher, or coach.

* Instruct them to mail the form immediately after they are filled out.

When the Camp Committee gets all of your forms back, they will make a decision and inform you by either letter or phone call. If you have any questions, contact Dale Kinkade (330) 898-2137.

SERVICE CREW JOB DESCRIPTION

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A born again Bible believing Christian who demonstrates Christian character and has potential leadership ability.
2. Minimum age - 14 years
3. Be familiar with the Brigade programs at Stony Glen Camp and/or within the local church.

RESPONSIBLE TO: The Camp Director and/or Service Crew Supervisor

RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Complete all forms and applications.
2. Send out prayer support letters after you are accepted as a member.
3. Serve in the area of kitchen and/or sanitation - must be willing to do either.
4. Work as part of a group and contribute toward the camp ministry as a team member.
5. Maintain a service crew schedule (will be provided).

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. In the kitchen, set tables, wash dishes, assist in passing out meals, and assist cooks where needed.
2. On sanitation, keep all common buildings and grounds clean on a daily basis, empty trash, and assist janitor when needed.
3. Enforce safety and health regulations.
4. Work closely with other service crew members to develop a "team spirit."
5. Develop an overview of Brigade camp philosophy and leadership.

Note: This position requires each service crew member to have access to secured areas. At any point in the week, the Camp Director reserves the right to send a service crew member home if the Director lacks trust in that member or the member is not building team unity by his effort.
