Personality Trait Definitions

- Commitment - The applicant has a personal relationship and commitment to Jesus Christ. His dedication to God is evident in every phase of his life - athletics, school church, social life, work and home.
- Enthusiasm - The applicant is enthusiastic about the task at hand.
- Fairness - The applicant has a sense of justice that causes him to treat others in such a way that no one is slighted or harmed.
- Responsibility - The applicant shows integrity and does what he says when others are depending on him.
- Submissiveness - The applicant is willing to follow the direction and leadership of those in authority over him. This includes parents, teachers, church leaders, and peers who have been placed in leadership positions. This submission is apparent even when the applicant may not fully agree with the one in authority.
